Services Description:

1) Admissions and Continuing Education

Acumen's Student Services staff can provide professional advice on program admission requirements, assist students after a successful completion of ESL program as well as help them with continuing education.

2) Student Orientation

On the first day of each semester, Ace Acumen Academy conducts an Orientation Day for all new students. The orientation session includes placement interview and testing as well as academic policies, student rights and responsibilities, staff introduction, insurance coverage, banking, emergency response procedures, gym membership and more. Students also get a chance to explore Acumen's campus facilities and communicate with the current students.

3) Medical Insurance

Every student who is enrolled at Ace Acumen Academy is entitled to health insurance coverage. Insurance packages are distributed to students at the beginning of each semester.

4) Disability Counselling

Our school is committed to help and assist students with any type of disability. Should the students be aware of such, they ought to contact Student Services in order to make special arrangements.

6) Fitness and Health Promotion

Ace Acumen Academy provides an optional discounted membership to LA Fitness for **\$80.00** per semester. Should the students be interested in exploring this opportunity, they may sign up at Student Services.

7) Students' Settlement Assistance

Should new students require any help with their settlement in a new city, Ace Acumen Academy can always assist them with airport pick-up, housing arrangement as well as banking and much more. Students are also given an opportunity to apply for a Homestay, which can be arranged by Ace Acumen Academy staff.

8) Immigration Guidance

Ace Acumen Academy provides free immigration guidance to those students may wish to study beyond a six-month period or go to a college program later on. Acumen's assistance includes student visa extension, visitor visa, working holiday visa, and a study permit for overseas students. Our on-site ICCRC member is available to advice our students on any of the new immigration rules coming into effect.
