


















Ontario Secondary School Diploma OSSD

It is one of the most advanced educational qualifications globally, widely accepted by top universities and educational institutions. The OSSD prepares students for success at universities around the world and is designed to provide a high-quality K-12 educational foundation.

Students who graduate with an OSSD do not need to undergo additional university entrance exams (such as SAT, ACT, etc.) for admission into top Canadian and global universities. CREDIT TRANSFER FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IS BASED ON AN OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT COVERING THE PAST THREE YEARS OF STUDY. THE MINIMUM REQUIRED SCORE FOR IBDP COURSES IS 4. TOK MAY BE CONVERTED INTO 1 CREDIT, PROVIDED THE OSSD PREREQUISITE COURSE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.
